- Fall haul-out planning: Haul-outs are being scheduled for Monday-Friday, mornings and afternoons. Boats need to be in the upper harbor the day of haul-out. Contact Kristina to schedule.
- Gas dock sold 2,000 gallons this last weekend. This year we have sold 12,000 gallons. Last year we sold 28,000, 2019 we sold 21,000.
- Gas pump service will be here Wednesday to repair the existing pump yet again.
- New gas pump pricing from three companies ranges between \$23-25,000. New equipment, processing, labor for installation, etc. We are waiting on one more pump/service provider for a quote. Pump will need wi-fi.
 - Connie from Blue Horizon was managing our wi-fi. We will need to follow-up with that and make sure what we
 do or don't have.
- Marinago setup and conversion. Kristina is reviewing the existing setup to make sure the details are setup correctly.
 Winter storage bills may be delayed to the 20th due to setup delays.

gas line update: plumbing is ready. Brian is assembling the meters that will go on each of the live-aboard boats this winter.

Dredging: How are operations going with the dredge?

What does the crew think of the equipment and our ability to continue operations? It's been a learning curve with Curt, Brian and Greg D., The dredge is versatile and will be very useful to our marina.

Have we documented lessons learned, tying together the activity and cut locations with volumes remove? We're working on that as we learn from dredging operations.

Have we progressed with a fixed drainage/ silting pond? No, we would need to pay for engineering and it would take such a huge chunk of our available yard. Adding more pipe adds more labor to setup. It already takes a good part of a day to get setup for dredging operations.

How many cubic yards of silt has been removed? About 1,000 from the entrance, lift and service wells, and fairway in front of clubhouse.

Gas pump purchase – installation plans: New gas pump pricing from three companies ranges between \$23-25,000. New equipment, processing, labor for installation, etc. We are waiting on one more pump/service provider for a quote.

Pump-out plan: We have not received the pump yet. We may get it late this year and will need to install it in the spring if that is the case.

Social: Chair - Kristina Cummings Our next event is the chicken feed which will be in September 25th. The Halloween party is October 9th. The Christmas party will be December 18th at the St. Paul hotel. We will need a new social chair for next year. Bobbi Daly has some interest and Lynn will talk with her more about it.

Community Project: Chair-Barb Haake The community project funding request for \$500,000 for 50,000 cubic yards of dredging by the COE will be included in a funding bill later this year. We can hope that it is included and passed, but we won't really know until that bill goes before the house and senate for passage.
